CARTHAGE TITLE IX PROCESS

A report of sexual violence is received by Public Safety, the Office of Student Life, the Office of Residential Life, or other campus community member responsible for reporting Title IX concerns.

The report is shared with the Title IX coordinator

Title IX staff contacts you to request a meeting to provide information, resources, options, and to explain the investigation process.

YOU CHOOSE to meet and discuss resources and options. Options include:

- supportive measures such as a no contact order, counseling services, class reassignment, etc.
- filing a formal complaint and pursue a sexual harassment proceeding under this Policy, and that such a proceeding will occur independently of any criminal investigation and proceeding

YOU CHOOSE NOT to meet with a Title IX staff member.

Your case is documented and may be part of statistics in an annual Clery Report.

YOU CHOOSE to pursue interim measures but not file a formal complaint at this time. A formal complaint can be filed at any time as long as both individuals involved are still affiliated with Carthage College.

YOU CHOOSE to file a formal complaint.

Carthage initiates a Title IX investigation.
